The story (so far)...

- 1998 – started as the Bromsgrove Youth Homelessness Forum because of the lack of support in the area for young people who had been homeless or grown up in care.
- 2000 – registered as a charity with the Charities Commission
- 2004 – became a registered company located in the Basement of the Baptist Church
- 2010 – changed the name to the North Worcestershire Basement Projects (operating as The Basement Project) to better reflect that we support people from across North Worcs.
- 2013 – flooding in the Basement caused us to seek new premises in Hanover Street.
- 2018 – celebrate 20th anniversary with a dinner for staff, trustees, volunteers and supporters
